
## COUNSELS 2024-2026



About 500 Catholics from the Archdiocese of Kuala Lumpur, the Diocese of Penang, and the Diocese of Malacca Johore participated in this assembly. We offer them to the Peninsular Church for their pastoral reflection and application, encouraging each to adapt these recommendations to their own unique context. These counsels are also an important part of our discernment process with the Catholic Church of Sabah and Sarawak as we journey towards the Malaysia Pastoral Convention 2026 (MPC2026).

# COUNSELS

Why Counsels? The RPA2024 is an important part of our journey towards MPC2026. While we cannot foresee exactly what will emerge, we are working toward a deeper communion of the Catholic Church across Semenanjung, Sabah, and Sarawak.

Each region will hold its own RPA, and what emerges from the discernments will form the framework for discussions and further discernment at MPC2026.

We refer to the discernments as **counsels** because while we work towards MPC2026, these **counsels** can serve as an aid and guidelines in the pastoral considerations of each diocese within its own unique context.

#### These **Counsels** comprise of:

- 1. **Keyword** such as "accompanying" that captures the essence of our counsel in moving forward.
- 2. **Rationale** that sheds light on the pastoral thrust behind it.
- 3. **Key pastoral recommendations** that emerged from our communal discernment.

It is by this, we hope that each within their own context can move forward toward building areas of their pastoral concerns—whether related to Family, Church, Ecology, or Society.

This is how we can walk together towards MPC2026 and beyond, in a spirit of communion, participation, and mission.
